

South Fraser CRN Regional Community Protocols

(Delta, Surrey, White Rock)

Introduction

With the financial support of the Public Guardian and Trustee, representatives from the Delta, North and Central Surrey and South Surrey/White Rock Community Response Networks (CRNs) formed a Protocol Development Working Group to undertake the task of developing a Community Protocol.

Using a template, also provided by the Public Guardian and Trustee, the Working Group began meeting in June 2003 to craft a Community Protocol that would be adopted and implemented by the members of these three CRNs.

In December 2003, after several meetings involving lengthy discussions and several revisions, the Protocol Development Working Group, met with representatives from the Fraser Health Authority and Ministry for Children and Family Development and accepted further feedback and subsequently recommended acceptance by each of the three CRNs of the South Fraser CRN Regional Community Protocols. These documents were then circulated to the membership of each of the three CRNs for final comment and accepted..
