# **(CRN)**

British Columbia's Adult Guardianship Legislation aims to protect adults who are abused or neglected and unable to seek support and assistance for themselves.

If you suspect or witness abuse or neglect please contact or refer to the appropriate agency listed in this Directory. We hope that easy access to contact information will allow you to support and assist those in need of help more effectively.

ABUSE is any action by someone in a position of trust, whether friend, family, or caregiver, which causes harm to another human being. It is the mistreatment of an adult that causes physical, mental, or emotional harm, or damage to or loss of assets.

Abuse can be:

- Financial
- Physical
- Psychological or emotional
- Sexual
- Medication abuse
- Violation of civic or human rights

NEGLECT is any failure to provide necessary care, assistance, guidance or attention to an adult that causes the adult serious physical, mental or emotional harm or damage to or loss of assets. Neglect may be intentional or unintentional due to lack of knowledge or interest, and may include self-neglect.

Look for signs of abuse:

- Sudden changes in wills, unusual bank withdrawals
- An older person is rarely seen outdoors or in the community
- Someone appears to be frightened of certain family members, friends, or caregivers
- A person appears to have frequent or unexplained injuries
- A person is withdrawn, anxious, depressed; may be the result of over or under medication
- Denial of food, clothing, medical attention or other necessities

The Kamloops Community Response Network is a group of individuals, service providers and designated agencies working together to enhance and coordinate the community's ability to respond to the abuse, neglect and self-neglect of adults who are vulnerable.

**CRN Vision**

The Kamloops Community Response Network works toward every individual, regardless of vulnerability, living free of abuse, neglect and self-neglect. We envision policy, individuals, service providers and designated agencies working together to build a community where all live with dignity and respect.

**Designated Agencies**

Designated Agencies in the directory are mandated to investigate reports of abuse, neglect or self-neglect if the following conditions are present: physical restraint, or a physical handicap that limits ability to seek help, or an illness, disease, injury or other condition that affects ability to make decisions about the abuse or neglect.

**How can you get involved?**

The Kamloops CRN consists primarily of representatives from organizations working in our community with seniors, people with disabilities, immigrant populations, victims and many

other vulnerable adults. New members are welcome, especially those affected by the Adult Guardianship legislation.

The Kamloops and District Elizabeth Fry Society provides some host to the Kamloops CRN, but the Network belongs to the community.
